

GARAGE SALE REGULATIONS

- 1) DO NOT POST SIGNS ABOUT THE GARAGE SALE OTHER THAN ON THE SITE OF THE SALE.*
- 2) DO NOT DISPLAY ITEMS FOR SALE WITHIN FIVE (5) FEET OF PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY.
- 3) GARAGE SALE MAY ONLY BE CONDUCTED AFTER 8 A.M. AND BEFORE 6 P.M.
- 4) THE PERMIT IS ONLY GOOD ON ASSIGNED DAYS. YOUR SALE MAY RUN THREE CONSECUTIVE DAYS OR TWO CONSECUTIVE WEEKENDS (OF TWO-DAY DURATION EACH).
- 5) ANY VIOLATION OF THE REGULATIONS ESTABLISHED FOR THE GARAGE SALES MAY RESULT IN YOUR BEING ISSUED A CITATION AND/OR YOUR GARAGE SALE BEING CLOSED.
- 6) APPLICANTS LIVING IN MULTIPLEX UNITS (TWO OR MORE UNITS ON THE SAME PREMISES) MUST PROVIDE A STATEMENT OF CONCURRENCE FROM THE OTHER TENNANTS AND THE PROPERTY OWNER. THIS IS TO INSURE THAT NOTICE HAS BEEN GIVEN OF THE SALE, AND THAT THEY ARE AWARE THAT NO OTHER GARAGE SALE MAY BE CONDUCTED WITHIN THAT CALENDAR QUARTER.

*No sign posted advertising the sale may be in excess of four (4) square feet in area, and may only be displayed during the actual hours of the sale.

GARAGE SALE ORDINANCES

- Section 11.10.010 Any person who shall offer for sale miscellaneous items of personal property on residential property for sale to the general public by means of a garage sale, patio, backyard or similarly called sale shall first obtain a permit as required in this chapter.
- Section 11.10.020 Personal property offered for sale shall not be displayed within five feet of the public right-of-way of any residentially zoned premises, provided, however, that a vehicle offered for sale may be displayed on a permanently constructed driveway within such front or side yards.
- Section 11.10.030 Before any garage sale, patio, backyard or similarly called sale shall be conducted, the person conducting such sale shall file a written application for a permit with the city clerk, which shall set forth:
- a) The name and address of the applicant and the names and addresses of any persons owning an interest in the property to be sold, if different from the applicant and an indication of the property owned by others other than the applicant.
 - b) The location of the proposed sale;
 - c) The date or dates during which the proposed sale is to be conducted.
 - d) An affidavit or declaration under penalty of perjury that the person or persons conducting the sale is or are the owners of the property offered for sale, that the property has not been acquired or assigned to the applicant or applicants for the purpose of resale and that no previous sale has been conducted by the applicant or on the premises within the calendar quarter in which the sale is to be conducted. As used herein, "calendar quarter" means one of the following four three-month periods in any given calendar year: January-March, April-June, July-September, and October-December.
- Section 11.10.050 No permit shall be approved and no sale shall be permitted for more than three consecutive days or two consecutive weekends of two days each. The sale shall not be conducted before 8:00 a.m. or after 6:00 p.m. on the permitted days.
- Section 11.10.060 **No sign advertising any sale for which a permit is required under this Chapter shall exceed four square feet in area. No such sign shall be displayed at any location off the premises nor at times other than the permitted times of the sale.**
- Section 11.10.070 Every person who either for himself or as the agent of another, commences, engages in, conducts or carries on any sale as provided in this Section without procuring the permit required by this Chapter or who fails to comply with the conditions and provisions of this Chapter shall be guilty of an infraction.
