CONSOLIDATING THE ELECTION WITH THE NOVEMBER  
7, 2006 STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION, AND  
REQUESTING MONTEREY COUNTY ELECTION  
OFFICIALS COMPLETE ELECTION TASKS

**RECOMMENDATION:**

**That the Council approve attached Resolution, which calls for a General Municipal Election to be held on November 7, 2006, and requests the Monterey County Elections Department to provide for consolidation of the election with the general statewide election on that day.**

**DISCUSSION:**

The City is scheduled to hold a municipal election this year. Procedurally, the City is required to adopt a resolution stating the date and time of the election. Also, in order to consolidate the municipal election with the general statewide election, the resolution must also request from Monterey County such a consolidation. This year the City Council positions subject to election are the Mayor and three City Council Members. The affected Council Members are: Lisa Bennett, Susan Goldbeck and Ron Schenk.

The attached resolution calls for the election to be held on Tuesday, November 7, 2006. The recommended action is to approve the resolution, which will be sent to the Monterey County Elections Department. A Notice of Election will be published by the Monterey County Department of Elections between 120 and 90 days prior to the election.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

The estimated cost of the election is \$18,000, which will be included as an item in the 2006/2007 budget in the City Council Department.

**RESOLUTION NO.**

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFIC GROVE (1) CALLING FOR A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF PACIFIC GROVE ON THE SEVENTH DAY OF NOVEMBER 2006, FOR THE ELECTION OF A MAYOR AND COUNCILMEMBERS, AND FOR ANY INITIATIVE MEASURE QUALIFYING FOR THE BALLOT; AND (2) REQUESTING THE COUNTY TO PROVIDE FOR CONSOLIDATION OF SAID ELECTION WITH THE GENERAL STATEWIDE ELECTION**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Charter of the City of Pacific Grove and the General Laws of the State of California, a General Municipal Election will be held in the City of Pacific Grove on Tuesday, November 7, 2006, for the election of a mayor for the full term of two years, and three councilmembers for the full term of four years each;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFIC GROVE DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. In accordance with Article 8 of the Charter of the City of Pacific Grove, the General Election of the City of Pacific Grove shall be held in the City on Tuesday, November 7, 2006, from the hours of 7:00 o'clock A.M. until 8:00 o'clock P.M., at which latter hour the polls shall be closed.

SECTION 2. Qualified electors at said election shall be entitled to vote for nominees, hereinafter to be identified and determined for the following offices:

- (a) Office of Mayor for a two year term, with one person to be elected;  
and
- (b) Office of Councilmember for four year terms, with three persons to be elected;

SECTION 3. Notwithstanding Section 2, in the event a currently seated Councilmember whose term does not expire in 2006 files as a candidate for the Office of Mayor, pursuant to Article 12 of the City Charter that Councilmember's term of office shall automatically expire on the Tuesday next succeeding the general municipal election held following that filing, and qualified electors at said election shall be entitled to vote for nominees, hereinafter to be identified and determined for the following offices:

- (a) Office of Mayor for a two year term, with one person to be elected;  
and
- (b) Office of Councilmember for four year terms, with three persons to be elected; and
