Purpose Statement

The purpose of the Museum Board is to:

1. Serve as an informational conduit between the public, the Museum Foundation of Pacific Grove (Foundation), and the City of Pacific Grove's staff and City Council;
2. Advise the city on questions relating to all matters of the Pacific Grove Museum of Natural History;
3. Participate in the ongoing development, updating, and implementation of the City and Foundation's lease agreement, and;
4. Perform such other duties relating to the Museum and other City facilities, functions, or activities as the Council may require by ordinance or resolution.

From the City Charter, Article 26c:

c. Museum Board. There shall be a Museum Board consisting of five members and shall have the following powers and duties.

(1) Act in an advisory capacity to the Council and City Manager in all matters pertaining to the operation of a public museum.

(2) Recommend to the City Council the adoption of such laws, rules, and regulations as it may deem necessary for the administration and protection of the City Museum.

(3) Perform such other duties relating to the museum service as the Council may require by ordinance or resolution.
