The following locations were deleted from the list and the reasons for deletion are noted:

1. Eardley Avenue stop sign at Lighthouse Avenue – Refer to the Traffic Commission
2. Central Avenue X-walk @ Eardley Avenue – Refer to the Traffic Commission
3. Central Avenue X-Walk @ Dewey Avenue – Refer to the Traffic Commission
4. Laurel Avenue and Grand Avenue – Refer to the Traffic Commission

The following locations were added to the list:

1. Other Intersections w/Lighthouse – Lobos to 13th – Lighthouse Workshop
2. Sidewalk Gap Construction – Pacific Grove Federally Classified Streets

7. Jewell, Pacific & Caledonia – *Pedestrian Crossing across Jewell*
8. Fountain Avenue & Central Avenue – *Lighthouse Design Workshop*
9. Ocean View Ave Access to Recreation Trail – *Fountain, Grand & Forest*

10. Forest Avenue (Rt 68) @ Forest Hill Boulevard – Pedestrian Assessment
10. Fountain @ Lighthouse Avenue – *Lighthouse Design Workshop*
12. Forest Avenue crosswalk @ Grove Market – Pedestrian Assessment
13. Forest Avenue @ Sinex Avenue – Traffic Signal Upgrade
14. David Avenue – *SaveMart Driveway westerly to end – Sidewalks*
15. Central Avenue @ Grand Avenue – *Lighthouse Design Workshop*
16. Lighthouse Avenue @ 17th Street – *Lighthouse Design Workshop*
