The Commissioners reviewed the revised list and requested that the proposed improvements for each site be included in the list. The Commissioners discussed various concerns including how important is the prioritized list, and the ability of the City to undertake these projects. Celia reported that the priority will assist Public Works in applying for grants to complete projects. Celia also reported that many of the projects will be eligible for funding. These funds are issued on a competitive basis so it could take some of these projects a few years to materialize. The City is developing a City wide list of Capital Improvement Projects and our priority list will enable the City to consider the placement of projects on this list.

This is the last meeting of the Sub Committee of the Traffic Safety Commission. Everyone is to be thanked for their time and effort with this project. This priority list will enable the City of Pacific Grove to actively compete for funds to improve pedestrian safety in our City.
