## REBUTTAL TO ARGUMENT AGAINST MEASURE O

**Don't be fooled by misinformation. GET THE FACTS!**

*81% of the city budget funds employee compensation.*     **MISLEADING!**

**FACT:**

Like all cities, Pacific Grove provides valuable services to its residents. WHO provides those services? City employees.

*Since 2005/2006 the City Manager's budget doubled, from \$393K to \$862K.*     **MISLEADING!**

**FACT:**

In the City Manager's office, there are two vacant positions -- Management Analyst and Principle Analyst -- there are no current plans to fill these positions. Due to a shortage of revenues, Pacific Grove has put in place a hiring freeze.

*The finance department is hiring two more \$100K+ bureaucrats.*     **WRONG!**

**FACT:**

The Finance Department has, in fact, hired a Senior Accountant. There are no current plans to hire the other position, an Information Systems Analyst.

*PG recently hired a \$150K/year Deputy City Manager.*     **WRONG!**

**FACT:**

The position of Deputy City Manager replaced the former Administrative Services Director.

Providing city services requires a professional and competent administration. It has become very clear that the cost of operating in the dark is far more expensive than the cost of having quality accounting and finance personnel on staff. Pacific Grove is undergoing a reorganization of City administration. This means moving positions from one department to another. When a position moves to another department, the planned expenses move also. This makes good business sense. Why have people in every department doing the same type of job that one centralized person could do?



## REBUTTAL TO ARGUMENT AGAINST MEASURE P

### ***Don't short-change Pacific Grove!***

*PG's 2007/2008 budget calls for hiring 16 additional full time employees and 20 new part-timers.*  
**WRONG!**

#### **FACT:**

The 06/07 budget staffing summary shows 135 full-time and 100 part-time employees. In 07/08, it calls for 131 full-timers and 106 part-timers. Pacific Grove has already initiated a hiring freeze.

How are *you* planning for next year? If something happens to change your budget of income and expenses, what then? You'll make adjustments in spending. Pacific Grove is no different. A budget is a PLAN for next year to provide all the services we deserve.

*The City Attorney is slated to require \$284K.*     **MISLEADING!**

#### **FACT:**

Every city needs legal advice. Our elected officials and city administrators are not lawyers. If city services are cut, we expose ourselves to greater liabilities and higher legal fees.

*PG spent \$135,000 on audits, consultants and polls. **None** of these recommendations were implemented by the Council.*     **WRONG!**

#### **FACT:**

Pacific Grove has implemented the following consultant recommendations:

- Added a Director of Management and Budget
- Created new procedures to control spending
- Created budget and finance policies
- Added a Senior Accountant
- Issued a new bond to reduce the cost of the pension obligation

*PG took over golf course management, hiring a \$100K golf pro and 12 part timers, exacerbating the CALPERS retirement burden.*     **MISLEADING!**

#### **FACT:**

Part-timers DO NOT qualify for CalPERS benefits. A golf course requires a golf professional. Even with new employees, the City is realizing an increase in profit over the previous concession arrangement.

REBUTTAL TO ARGUMENT AGAINST MEASURE Q

***Don't lose what defines Pacific Grove to partial facts and half-truths!***

*Revenues up 7% annually since 2002.      **WRONG!***

**FACT:**

City revenues grew from \$11,840,337 in 2002 to an estimated \$14,992,679 in 2007. That averages 4.4% annually; however, EXPENSES increased an average of 5% annually. You know from your household budget that less money coming in than going out spells disaster! This is why we must increase revenues NOW.

*PG's population fell in the past decade yet the budget rose.      **MISLEADING!***

**FACT:**

Has the number of people in your household increased or decreased in the last 10 years? Have your expenses remained the same as in 1997? OF COURSE NOT. Because of inflation nothing costs the same as it did 10 years ago. You can't avoid these cost increases as a consumer, and neither can the City. Your rent or mortgage is the same whether there are 2 people or 10 living in your home; likewise, the cost to run the city does not depend on the number of people who live here. In fact, the costs of library, police, fire and other services are likely to rise despite any decrease in population.

*Mismanaged PG squanders \$260K annually on overtime pay.      **MISLEADING!***

**FACT:**

Ask yourself whether spending money on fire and police officers to protect yourself and your family is "squandering" money. Because that's where roughly 95% of that overtime pay goes. Multiple vacant positions in public safety have required overtime hours in order to protect YOU!
