



PACIFIC GROVE POLICE MOTORCYCLE COMPETITION



COURSE DESCRIPTION AND SAMPLE LAYOUT

Total course length is approx. 600' ft. and covers a 4 lane roadway approx 80' ft. in width. Past courses have consisted of lock to lock turning, synchronized cone weaves, stopping with no foot down and a de-cell to finish, stopping with front tire in the box stops the time. Obviously we will not provide you with the competition course until the day before the event at the competitor briefing. We have provided a sample course for review and practice. In recent years riders have been asked to ride certain sections in tandem so practice both solo-tandem riding. Judges are looking for synch, accuracy and time.

Tips:

- **All weaves are entered from the right**
- **Emergency lights must be on during the runs, this means both riders**

Keep in mind that the judges are looking for :

- **Accuracy – No cones down, no feet down, no missed turns**
- **Synchronicity – Both riders riding evenly and in synch**
- **Time – The rides are timed and this time is factored into the total**
